Owatonna Bus Company – Aides Needed! Approximate Hours: 7:00am – 8:30-am, 11:30am – 12:30am, and 2:00pm – 3:30pm

Duties: help students buckle/unbuckle, help with backpacks, coats, hats, mittens, help keep the students happy by having lighthearted conversations, singing, etc, help with loading, securing, and unloading of wheelchairs.

Pay: based on length of route and experience/qualifications - \$12 - \$15 per hour(routes usually an hour but some can be an hour and a half)
